

The device connected to the serial port sends data without special request. When Windows recognizes the serial port, such data may be misinterpreted as a serial mouse attached to that port.

Open the Device Manager, and open the Properties of the Com Port. In "Port Settings" click the '<u>A</u>dvanced...&#39; button. Then uncheck the option &#39;Serial Enumerator&#39;. Now Windows will no longer attempt to recognize devices at this port.
