

OnRISC: How could BIOS prior 2.1 be updated to the latest version?

The update image format has changed since 2.1. To be able to update to BIOS version 2.9 one will have to update to BIOS 2.1 first and then make an update to the newer version. Beginning with BIOS 2.1 there are two ways updating BIOS:

- via console
- via network using [netcat](#) or [socat](#)

Alternatively you can strip off 2 first bytes (hex 0x1b and 0xb5) of the *.b64 file via hex editor like for example [HxD](#) and update directly from BIOS 1.0 or 2.0.
