

*USB to Serial: With USB-COM the mouse cursor erratically jumps around the screen.*

The device connected to the serial port sends data without special request. When Windows recognizes the serial port, such data may be misinterpreted as a serial mouse attached to that port.

Open the Device Manager, and open the Properties of the Com Port. In "Port Settings" click the *Advanced...* button. Then uncheck the option *Serial Enumerator*. Now Windows will no longer attempt to recognize devices at this port.
