

## *VScom Serial Device Servers: How to install unsigned drivers in Windows 10/11?*

Windows 8, 10, and 11 include a "driver signature enforcement" feature. This feature prevents NetCom driver installation and must be deactivated in order to proceed with the installation. This [article](#) shows the required steps.

Another problem is the core isolation feature in Windows. This is often on by default or enforced through corporate security policy and has to be deactivated to install the NetCom driver. This [article](#) shows the required steps.
